IN MEMORY...

Patricia Ann Sovich Silverdale, WA Nov. 6, 1937 to Jan. 17, 2017

Captain Patricia A. Sovich, NC, USN (RET) of Silverdale died on Jan. 17, 2017 after an unexpected illness. Pat served her country for 30 years as a nurse and hospital administrator, with her last duty station in Bremerton. Overseas assignments took her to Vietnam, Japan, Guam and England. Stateside she was stationed in North Carolina, Maryland, Tennessee and California.

Pat graduated as a registered nurse from Saint Clare's Hospital School of Nursing in New York City. After commissioning into the Navy Nurse Corps, she received her bachelor's degree from the University of Pennsylvania and her master's from Arizona State University.

Pat was the oldest of five siblings, all military veterans. She was very active in her church, and "Stand Up For Kids" was particularly close to her heart. Most important to her was her involvement in the Secular Franciscan Order, a community of Catholic men and women who seek to pattern their lives after Jesus in the spirit of Francis of Assisi. She truly embodied that aspiration.

Today's Navy Corpsmen: Corpsmen Jobs and Joint Military Training

The role of Navy Corpsmen is as diverse and challenging as ever. Starting in 2011, training for all military medical services combined as part of the "Purple Medical Service" concept. The foundational enlisted medical course work is done for all services at the Military Education and Training Center (METC) at Fort Sam Houston, San Antonio, Texas. Anne Mulligan visited METC last year as part of her doctoral work to award higher education credit for military medical education and training. Anne will share pictures, the innovative educational methods used, and her recommendations for helping corpsmen advance to baccalaureate prepared nurses.

Anne retired from Navy Hospital Bremerton in the fall of 2000 and started teaching the Practical Nursing Program at Olympic College (OC). She participated in program start up for the successful RN-BSN Program at OC, which was the first baccalaureate program in a community college in Washington State. She recently graduated from the University of Washington Tacoma's first Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership Degree with an emphasis in Nursing.

NWNNCA IS HOSTING THE 2018 NNCA REUNION!


